



National Credit Regulator

The National Credit Regulator (NCR) was established as the regulator under the National Credit Act 34 of 2005 (the Act) and is responsible for the regulation of the South African credit industry. It is tasked with carrying out education, research, policy development, registration of industry participants, i.e. credit providers, credit bureaux and debt counsellors, investigation of complaints, and enforcement of the Act. The Act requires the Regulator to promote the development of an accessible credit market, particularly to address the needs of historically disadvantaged persons, low income persons, and remote, isolated or low density communities. The NCR invites applications from suitable candidates for the following position:

Requirements:

- The suitable candidate must have the specialised technical expertise, to manage, host and maintain the system. The successful candidate will hold a 3-year IT qualification with at least 3 – 4 years' experience as an ICT applications development, implementation, and support and maintenance enhancement environment.

Duties:

The incumbent will be required to perform the following but will not be limited to :

- Documentation of the Design (forms) – document all aspects of the system.
- Document each functionality (process flow) and produce the process flow map of the system.
- Provide ICT related comments to critical scripts and procedures that enable the system to function properly.
- Verify input process that details how information is capture by the users.
- Perform automation, rectification of notifications on (system functionality, support and maintenance thereof).
- Document error-handling processes within the Debt Help system
- Perform ETL and provide meaningful reports to the Credit Bureaus and Debt Counsellors.
- Automation, rectification of FTP or SFTP configurations, functionality, support and maintenance thereof.
- Do a skills transfer to the internal ICT personnel.
- Provide support to the industry on any DHS related technical queries and
- Perform a hand over and a sign off to the NCR.
- Investigate, analyse and document reported defects (root cause analysis)
- Systems re-engineering
- ASP.net, C#, C, VB programming
