



The National Credit Regulator (NCR) was established as the regulator under the National Credit Act 34 of 2005 (the Act) and is responsible for the regulation of the South African credit industry. It is tasked with carrying out education, research, policy development, registration of industry participants, i.e. credit providers, credit bureaux, alternative dispute resolution agents, payment distribution agents and debt counsellors, investigation of complaints, and enforcement of the Act. The Act requires the NCR to promote the development of an accessible credit market, particularly to address the needs of historically disadvantaged persons, low income persons, and remote, isolated or low density communities. The NCR invites applications from suitable candidates for the following position:

Requirements:

The successful candidate must hold a national diploma and/or 3-year degree in the relevant field (preferable commerce and or business management with a minimum of 2 - 3 years relevant experience. Experience in a regulatory environment will be an added advantage.

Duties:

- Facilitate the end to end risk management process within NCR;
- Support the risk manager in providing the risk management service and support to all departments within the NCR;
- Facilitate the business continuity process within the organisation;
- Facilitate the risk champions forum and ensure that adequate training is provided to risk champions;
- Co-ordinate the outsourced internal audit services;
- Respond to audit related queries (internal and external auditors);
- Facilitate the review of 1st, 2nd and 3rd drafts APP;
- Monitor the department's deliverables on the APP and business plans;
- Facilitate the collation of quarterly reports and conduct the first quality review;
- Monitor adherence to compliance calendar and shareholders compact;
- Supervise and guide the junior operations officer within the organisation;
- Support Exco through their strategic deliverables;
- Participate in various relevant committees and Forums.

- DTI and National Treasury Regulations;
- South African consumer credit market;
- Understanding of the regulatory framework;

Skills:

- Good analytical skills;
- Good interpersonal relations;
- Computer literate;
- Excellent communication skills (both written and verbal);

- Planning and organising skills;
- Risk management.
